This began as a small swarm of magnetic cyanotype butterflies that I created in the summer/fall of 2012 and installed around the metal objects and environments of Indianapolis, Indiana. As I progressively added more individuals to the collection, I traveled around the country photographing the temporary installations and curating them into my blog. In 2015, I solicited participants from around the world to host 350 butterflies for two to five weeks. The project was an epic collaboration and produced thousands of images from hundreds of installations in 86 different countries. I completed this entire project with the support and time of the artist residency at the Tides Institute and Museum of Art in Eastport, Maine. The organization of this book hinged on the thematic, tonal, formal, structural and narrative shifts in each chapter of James Joyce's <u>Ulysses</u>, which I correlated to various artistic processes and material constraints. Many of these were collage-based with very specific and purposeful sources including anatomical, scientific and classical illustrations.
